December 2021

- Financial support to the Lady Cox Rehabilitation Centre in Stepanakert.

Projects implemented by the TCF in 2020

Due to COVID-19 the annual educational, cultural and other projects of the TCF were not implemented in 2020

December 2020

- Provision of food and essential goods to the Berdzor Tekeyan schoolchildren (the first phase of the programme "Support to our compatriots from Artsakh" - 51 refugee families).
- Assistance to G. Avanesyan from Artsakh in passing a medical examination and getting medicines.

November 2020

- Financial support to the staff of Berdzor Tekeyan School N1 (total 41 beneficiaries).

- “Free Textbooks – 2020/2021” provided 2,400 textbooks for free to 170 needy schoolchildren from V.Tekeyan schools in Yerevan, Gyumri, Stepanavan and Karbi.
