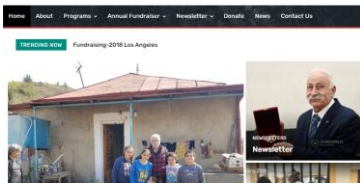
September 2023

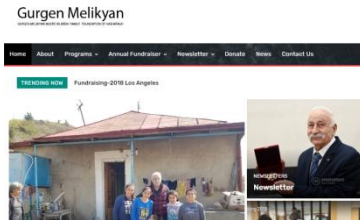
March 2022
